

Guidelines to enrolling cattle in the JRS Value-Added Programs

Producers **must** use the products from the Approved Pharmaceutical list. If non-approved vaccine and wormers are used the cattle will not be in compliance.

Producer must send in proof of purchase and send in completed JRS Value-Added form one week prior to sale date.

Producer must apply an approved nested EID Program tag.

JRS Calf-Vac Sourced: Calves must be born on producer's farm and given one round of shots within six weeks prior to sale date. These calves can be weaned but must still wear the calf-vac tag.
(White tag)

JRS Wean-Vac 45 Sourced: Calves must be born on producer's farm and given two round of shots. The second round booster **must** be given 2-5 weeks after the first round. Cattle must be weaned for a minimum of 45 days.
(Black tag)

JRS Wean-Vac 45 Non-sourced: Calves must be given two rounds of shots with the second round booster given 2-5 weeks after the first round. These calves must be weaned a minimum of 45 days. This program is for stocker cattle that are purchased and weaned for a minimum of 45 days.
(Orange tag)

In order to receive JRS/QSA tags you must be an Approved QSA Supplier. You **MUST** send in the QSA Enrollment form complete with group birth-date of calves being renrolled and QSA tag order form in before you can receive JRS/QSA tags. These two forms can be sent to JRS by mail (P.O. Box 634 Carthage, MO 64836) or by fax (417-548-2370). Please make these forms attention to Troy Watson.

JRS/QSA Calf-Vac: Producer must be an approved QSA supplier. Vaccination protocol **(Yellow tag)** is the same as the JRS Calf-Vac Sourced.

JRS/QSA Wean-Vac: Producer must be an approved QSA supplier. Vaccination protocol **(Yellow tag)** is the same as the JRS Wean-Vac 45 Sourced.

BE SURE TO SEND IN YOUR JRS VALUE-ADDED FORM IN AT LEAST ONE WEEK PRIOR TO SALE DATE.
